Dual-Purpose Alfalfa with Disease Resistance

Viking 394AP

Viking 394AP is a high forage yielding, good forage quality, sunken crown alfalfa variety selected for resistance to multiple races of *Aphanomyces* root rot and a broad spectrum of pest resistance. Sunken crown varieties do well in grazing and increased traffic scenarios. Viking 394AP is an excellent choice for a hay and graze dual-purpose alfalfa.
